

# TRAVEL OPTIONS TO STUDENTS TO AND FROM WOODLANDS SCHOOL

## Free Bus Passes

Free bus passes need to be applied for at Coventry City Council, Education, Student Support, applications need to be returned by the end of term. They are issued to students who have to travel 3 miles or more within the Coventry boundaries (not Warwickshire). A choice has to be made when applying whether the student wants a Centro bus pass or DeCoursey.

**Centro** passes can be bought towards the end of August at Pool Meadow or many local newsagents at a cost of:

Termly	£77
4 weekly	£26
Weekly	£7.25

Buses that travel to and from the school are the No. 10, 23C and 34. The parent can get up to date timetables from Pool Meadow (we do have some in Reception but they are September 2010 so I am unsure if times would have changed)

**DeCoursey** passes that are paid for have to be ordered from Finance by the end of term. The cost is:

Yearly	£234
Termly	£84
Daily	80p (going up to 90p in January) per journey

The only DeCoursey buses that run to and from the school are:

- 72     **Holbrook Lane** stops at Hollybush Public House 07.35, Jubilee Crescent 07.42, Moseley Avenue 07.51, Hearsall Common 08.00
  
- 73     **Allesley Park** terminus 07.55, Whitaker Road 08.01
